ITEM 1 – ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENTS

Pathway 1: ICAN Diploma of International Business to SWINBURNE Bachelor of Business (any major excluding double majors) or Bachelor of Accounting

Credit Arrangements: Students having completed ICAN Diploma of International Business will be eligible for credit exemption of up to 100 credit points.

Minimum duration to complete at Swinburne: 2 Years

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Pathway 2

Credit Arrangements: Students having successfully completed a program equivalent to an Australian Diploma at ICAN College (program must have minimum 90 credits and be accredited by the Malaysian Qualification Authority), will be eligible for a credit exemption of 8 unmatched electives units of 12.50 credit points each totalling 100 credit points from any of the programs of study specified in this document. This advanced standing reduces the minimum duration of study at Swinburne to the periods specified for each program listed below.

Minimum duration to complete at Swinburne: 2 Years
